Community Members

Parents and adult students are required to be community members for community member rates.

10 x Monthly Standing Order instalments

10 monthly amounts by standing order payable from 1st October 2016 - 1st July 2017 payable on 1st day of each month

1 child = 10 x £20, 2 children = 10 x £37, 3 children = 10 x £52, adult = 10 x £40

This can be set up very easily using internet banking or going into a bank. Please give your bank the Greek School account number and sort code and make sure you include the start date; **1st October 2015** and the end date; **1st July 2016** . Please include your surname as reference.

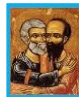
